



UVSA-Midwest Elections

E-Board is a two-year term, and voting will take place on March 27th at the VIA-1 Conference

Positions: President, External Vice-President, Internal Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary and (2) Board of Advisor positions

Executive Board Eligibility

- Be younger than 26 years of age at the time of election, and
- Have served as a former or current member of UVSA-Midwest, or have been an active member of UVSA-Midwest for at least 1-year
- Be approved by three fifths of the current Executive Board

Board of Advisors Eligibility

- Must be resident of the Midwest, and a United States Citizen
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years of experience with the Vietnamese communities and/or VSAs; with the exception of the current President
- Must have a bachelor degree from an accredited American college or university

Process

- Candidates will present a two-minute speech
- There will be Q&A session for President, Internal Vice-President and External Vice-President candidates
- Each constituent state will have time to deliberate
- The election process will conclude with the constituent state voting and declaring the majority winner as the state's vote. The vote will be executed by the UVSA-MW State Representative
